**What is a Servant Retreat?**

A Servant Retreat is a weekend opportunity for children, youth and adults of all ages to come together to serve in Jesus' name. The weekend will include worship, service, meals and fun!

**What can I expect if I sign up for this trip?**

You can expect to:

- Serve God by serving others.
- Strengthen your relationship with friends and family.
- Develop new friendships with people of a different generation than your own.
- Learn about the issues of justice and poverty in Southern Colorado.

**What will we do on the trip?**

We will work with the great team at La Puente in Alamosa to support their ministry. We will work at the food bank, help with the cooking for the center, build/fill commodity boxes, sort clothes, and winterize their gardens. We will also play, laugh, sing, and worship together.

**Who can go?**

The Cross Generational Servant Retreat is for adults, youth and children ages 7 and up. Any youth under the age of 18 must have a parent participating in the trip in order to sign up. Families are encouraged to sign up to go together but your family does not have to go in order for you to sign up! Singles are welcome to be part of this great experience!

**How much does it cost?**

Total cost for this trip is \$90/person. We ask that each person plan to pay \$45 for a deposit. We will attempt to fundraise the remainder in September and October. If we are unsuccessful in fundraising the balance then we will ask each person to contribute their portion of the remaining balance.

### Registration Deadline

The Registration for this trip is due on Sunday September 12.

### How will we get there?

Alamosa is about a four hour drive from Parker. We will use our own vehicles and carpool down and back. We will also use our own vehicles to get to and from the work site on Saturday and Sunday. Those who drive will be responsible for gas, those who ride are encouraged to help with gas money.

### Where will we stay?

A Presbyterian Church in Alamosa will host us for the weekend. They have showers, a kitchen and a large sleeping area. Everyone will be encouraged to bring a blow up mattress or sleeping pad, sleeping bag and pillow. We will be "roughing it"! It is kind of like camping inside a church.

### What will we eat?

We will prepare our own breakfast each day at the church. Our meals will be simple but plentiful and we will work around all food allergies. Some meals will be served to us by La Puente. Other meals we may prepare at church or go out to eat.

### Will it be hard work?

Yes! We will work hard while we are there. You can expect to get a little dirty and to be very tired at the end of each day. Work projects will be age appropriate and there will be something for every level of physical ability.
